X Cash

A cash bar is where attendees buy their own drinks for a set price as they would at any commercial bar.

X Consumption

A consumption bar, or a pay-by-consumption bar, where the host only pays for what their guests consume. These are great for hosts who don't have large drinking crowds, but want to provide some beverages.

X Hosted

A host bar, also called an open bar, is where the host pays for all the drinks. There are a variety of options available for hosted bars, including beer and wine with options to add champagne, specialty cocktails, top-shelf liquor and a multitude of upgrades.
